ASSOCIATED GUIDANCES ON BALLAST WATER MANAGEMENT CONVENTION

Agenda 4 will discuss revised guidance on ballast water sampling and analysis for trial in accordance with BWM Convention and guidelines (G2) in conjunction with the proposed addition of analytical methods in BWM.2/Circ.42 and view to the addition of the data gathering and analysis plan for the experience-building phase.

In addition the discussion have raised concern the practical constraints of the BWMTS commissioning test. While, agenda 5, will discuss the revised guidance on methodologies that may be used for enumerating viable organisms for approval BWMTS

REVIEW OF THE 2011 GUIDELINES FOR THE CONTROL AND MANAGEMENT OF SHIPS' BIOFOULING TO MINIMIZE THE TRANSFER OF INVASIVE AQUATIC SPECIES (RESOLUTION MEPC.207(62))

This agenda will cover further discussion on minimizing the biofouling introductions or transfers, especially the implementation of voluntary guidelines, " 2011 Guidelines for control and minimizing transfer of such species as biofouling " (MEPC.207(62)). REVISION OF MARPOL ANNEX IV AND ASSOCIATED GUIDELINES TO INTRODUCE PROVISIONS FOR RECORD-KEEPING AND MEASURES TO CONFIRM THE LIFETIME PERFORMANCE OF SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANTS

This agenda will discuss several proposals that address to introduce provisions for record-keeping and measures to confirm the lifetime performance of sewage treatment plants. PPR 7 will continue work on the following proposals:

- Commissioning testing of sewage treatment plants (STP)
- Indicative monitoring performance of STP
- Periodic control performance of STP
- Additional requirement: holding tank for untreated sewage
- Requirement for sampling point
- Sewage management plan
- Sewage record book
