HARMFUL AQUATIC ORGANISMS IN BALLAST WATER

This meeting agenda is expected to consider several matters such as:

- Approval of BWMS.
- Proposed unified interpretation of regulations E-1.1.1 and E-1.1.5 of the BWM Convention concerning mandatory commissioning testing and also unified interpretation of regulation B-3.10 of the BWM Convention concerning the deadline for compliance with the D-2 standard for specific cases.
- BWM circular on the application of the BWM Convention to ships operating at ports with challenging water quality.
- Other matters such as review of BWRB, various information updates on the experience-building phase (EBP) associated with the BWM Convention.

REDUCTION OF GHG EMISSIONS FROM SHIPS

In this meeting agenda, MEPC 77 will consider the following

- Draft guidelines on correction factors for certain ship types, operational profiles and/or voyages for the CII calculations.
- Draft updated Guidelines for the development of a SEEMP.
- Proposal to include information on the ship's required and attained Energy Efficiency Existing Ship Index (EEXI) and Carbon Intensity Indicator (CII) values and rating in the IMO Data Collection System (DCS) and including concomitant amendments to appendix IX of MARPOL Annex VI.

ANY OTHER BUSINESS

This meeting agenda will consider the proposal to amend paragraph 6.2.2 of the revised guidelines and specifications for pollution prevention equipment for machinery space bilges of ships (resolution MEPC.107(40)) regarding provision sending a light and sound alarm and stop overboard discharge of oily water when a 15 ppm bilge alarm has lost sample water. In addition, there are proposals on work related to Maritime Autonomous Surface Ships (MASS) which may be discussed for future committee session.
